13 To consider items brought to the Council by Members.

13.1 Cllr P Evans has asked that the Council consider the implications of the change which will replace all Rapid Response Vehicles in the Cwm Taff area with CHARUs (Cymru High Acuity Response Units) in September.

13.2 A proposal from Cllr P Evans that the Councils supports a local historical/photographic exhibition to be held in the town, location to be agreed.

13.3 A request from Cllr P Evans that we ask RCTCBC to increase the number of Dog Bins in the area, particularly around Brookfield & increase the activity to reduce the number of residents who do not dispose of dog poo in the correct manner.

13.4 A proposal from Cllr Maier that the Ynysybwl & Coed-y-Cwm Community Facebook page be made 'public' so items can be more widely shared when they originate on the page.

13.5 A proposal from Cllr Haines that the Council look into refurbishing the railings near the top of the 'Big Hill' & restore them to white. If possible, using local independent traders to help support our community.

13.6 A proposal by Cllr Haines that the Council look into fitting safety railings at the top gate of Clydach Park to prevent children running out of the park into the road. If possible, using independent local traders to help restore our community.
